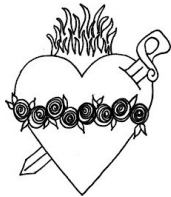

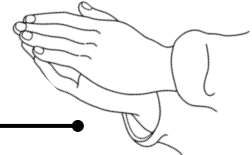

Ash Wednesday

Wednesday, February 14, is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the holy season of Lent. Ash Wednesday is **not** a Holy Day of Obligation. Although participating at Mass is not required on Ash Wednesday, it is a powerful way to start our Lenten journey. Masses will be:

- 9:00 am at Saint Joseph's, Trenton
- 12:00 noon at Blessed Sacrament, Bethany, and
- 6:00 pm at Immaculate Heart of Mary, Princeton

We are accepting last year's palms for burning, look for the baskets!



Liturgy During Lent

In recognition of the penitential nature of the upcoming Season of Lent, we will be changing some of our usual practices at Mass. As we did during this past Advent and during last Lent, we will be using Latin for the *Sanctus* (the “Holy, Holy, Holy”) and the *Agnus Dei* (the “Lamb of God”). Also, as last Lent, we will be chanting the Entrance Antiphon and the Communion Antiphon instead of singing hymns at the beginning of Mass and at Communion. We will also be using the First Form of the Penitential Act, the *Confiteor* (“I Confess”) followed by the *Kýrie eléison* (Κύριε, Ελέησον, “Lord, Have Mercy”) in Greek.

Furthermore, most weekdays during Lent, Fr. Bill Fox will not be preaching, but letting the Holy Spirit, through the Sacred Scriptures assigned to the day, speak for Himself.



Jesus and the Eucharist

“Jesus and the Eucharist” is a seven-part video and discussion faith formation designed by the bishops in the United States and the folks at the Augustine Institute. This small group study was specifically designed for this Year of Parish Revival as part of the three-year National Eucharistic Revival. Each session is full of rich theological content, powerful testimonies, and unique and timely messages from individual bishops across the country. Each of the seven sessions will include a 2-hour video which includes time for conversation.
